### **Bid Package to be Available August 2, 2019 for Plum Run Stream Restoration Phase 1.**

The Brandywine Red Clay Alliance (BRC) will be accepting bids for a **stream restoration project on Plum Run**. The project area is located on private property in East Bradford Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania. Work will involve streambank grading and stabilization, in-stream structures, erosion and sediment control measures per guidelines to be given at the mandatory site showing.

The bid package can be obtained starting on August 2, 2019 and is available on the BRC website [www.brandywineredclay.org](http://www.brandywineredclay.org).

A mandatory site showing is scheduled for August 13, 2019 at 9:00 AM at the project site (940 Tigue Road, West Chester, PA 19382). Contractors must have and include in the package a demonstrated experience in knowledge and construction of successful stream restoration projects incorporating fluvial geomorphology (FGM). Contractors must be familiar with the recommendations of the Pennsylvania Stream Team. Contractors are required to address all conditions of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP)/ United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) stream encroachment approvals and erosion and sediment control measures required by the Chester County Conservation District and PADEP Chapter 102 regulations. Contractors are required to address all conditions of Chester County Conservation District and PADEP Chapter 102 regulations. Approvals are in hand and issued to BRC for the project.

### **Last Day for Submission of Questions is August 22, 2019 by 5:00 PM**

**Bid packages are due by 10:00 AM on August 30, 2019 at the BRC office**, located 1760 Unionville-Wawaset Road, West Chester, PA 19382 and will be opened to the public at 10:05 AM, the same day.

Contractors should be ready to start work by October 1, 2019.
